Subject : Policy of Not Accepting Gifts and All Kinds of Presents for Performing
Duties (No Gift Policy) B.E. 2569 (2026)

The Office of the Private Education Commission Announcement attaches importance to upholding good governance in its administration and adopting integrity as a core value in the execution of duties. Therefore, it is committed to cultivating an organizational culture of transparency, opposing all forms of bribery and preventing the misuse of an authority or a position for personal interests or to benefit others.

To continuously implement anti-corruption policy, and in accordance with The National Reform Plan on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct, The Office of the Private Education Commission Announcement hereby declares its intention of opposing all forms of corruption. All government officials and staffs shall not accept gifts and all kinds of presents from performing duties (No Gift Policy) to prevent any possible form of bribery, conflicts of interest and improper action leading to unfavorable consequences of corruption, misconduct and discrimination. The executives and staffs at all levels must serve as good example and ensure subordinates' compliance with the code of conduct.
